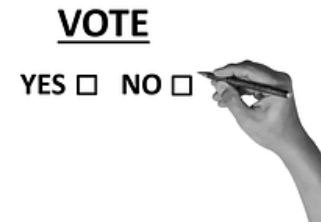


Rector's Letter for July and August 2024
